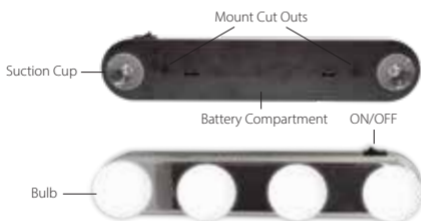

- 5) Adhere Vanity light in location
